



EMDR Training in Hong Kong, 2011

Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR) is a clinical treatment that involves elements from different therapeutic approaches with eye movements or other forms of stimulations which activate the information processing system of the brain. Millions of people worldwide were treated successfully. Case reports and controlled studies reported positive results with the use of this treatment.

The EMDR Association of Hong Kong is delighted to announce the next EMDR training which aims to prepare professionals to use EMDR in their practices. There are two parts: Part I for novices and Part II for those who took part I at least six months prior to the coming training, as well as participated in Groups Sharing and Case Consultation (GSCC) sessions.

Our trainer is Dr. Gary Quinn from Israel who is a senior trainer of the EMDR Institute USA. Dr. Quinn conducted our previous trainings and has received high ratings from our trainees.

Training Participation Pre-requisites:

- Part I: Professional level training in mental health, medical, social work, or counseling field, and with 2-3 yrs experience in one-to-one counseling.
- Part II: Having completed at least three (3) GSCC sessions of two hours each conducted by our qualified facilitators. For GSCC schedule, please refer to our website: www.hkemdr.org

Certificate of Attendance

- For Part-I trainees – after successful completion of Part-I training.
- For Part-II trainees – after successful completion of Part-II training, as well as completion of six (6) GSCC sessions (total of 12 hours) within six (6) months from Part-II training. .

Training fee:

- Confirmation of participation (official hard copy receipt will be provided during the training)
- Refund cheque for unsuccessful applications

Note: Successful applicants whose fee was not received in full (e.g. banking charges not covered by applicant) – will be required to pay the difference plus \$100 special handling fee upon start of training.

Cancellation Policy:

Refund of 80% for cancellations received 3 weeks before training or earlier. No refunds for later cancellations. Cancellations by email only.
